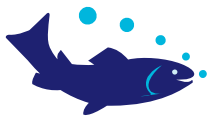

Learn how structural soil can be compacted to meet engineering requirements for paved surfaces, while still allowing roots to grow freely, under and away from the pavement, thereby reducing sidewalk heaving.
